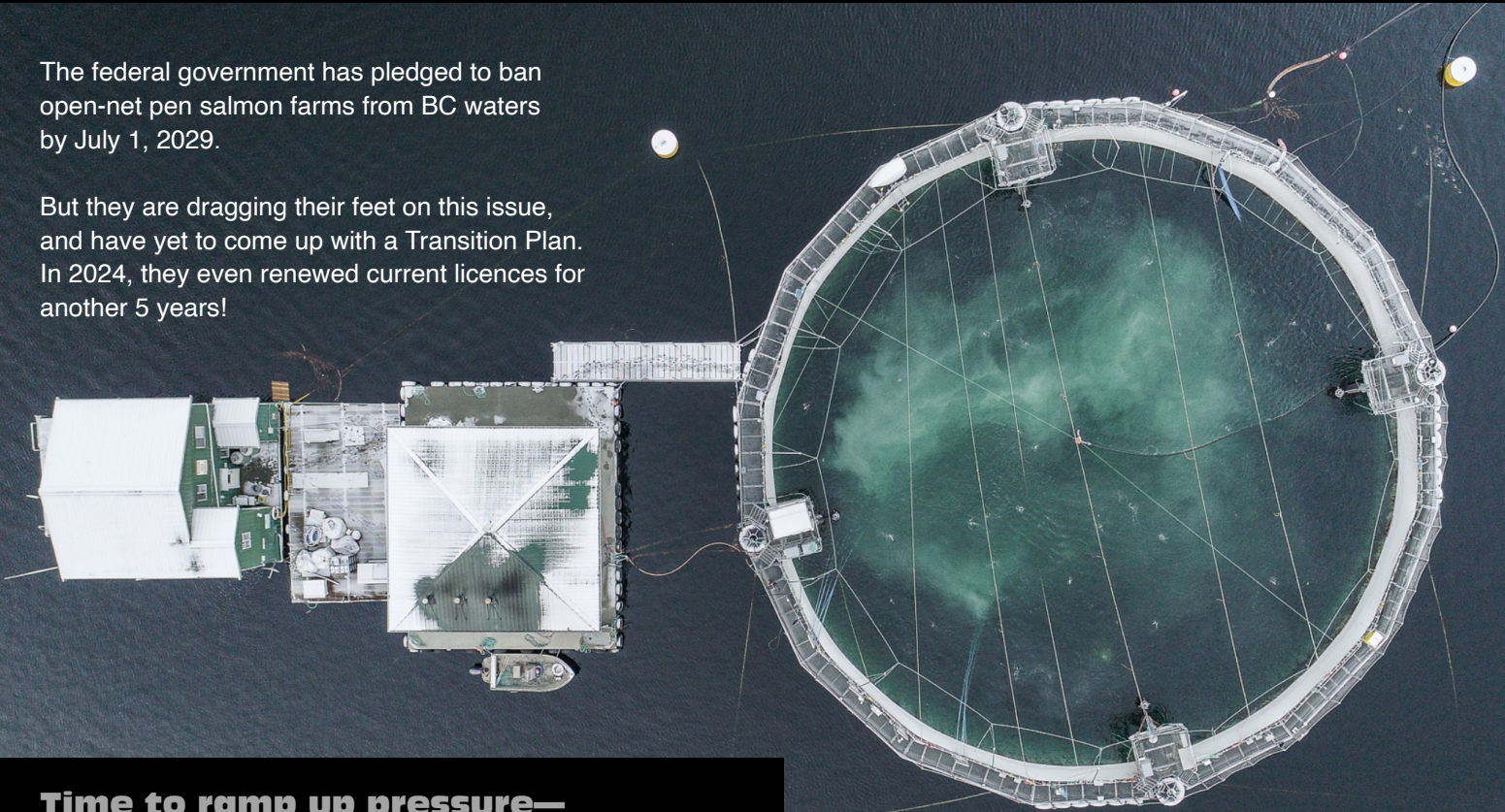




The federal government has pledged to ban open-net pen salmon farms from BC waters by July 1, 2029.

But they are dragging their feet on this issue, and have yet to come up with a Transition Plan. In 2024, they even renewed current licences for another 5 years!
